Ag deileáil le siomptóm nó le cás COVID-19 Dealing with the symptoms or a case of COVID-19



Students who exhibit any symptoms associated with COVID-19 should not attend Coláiste Feirste.

Positive tests must be immediately communicated to the school.

If pupils show symptoms of COVID-19 whilst in school the following will take place:

- The pupil will communicate with a member of staff
- The pupil will be taken to a designated, ventilated COVID room
- A COVID-19 officer will stay with the pupil and communicate with the office and contact the parent/guardian immediately
- Pupils will be handed over to parent/guardian in the main car park, safely
- Parent/guardian must sign a written record of actions taken and advice given
- Parent/guardian will contact PHA regarding guidance for households with possible coronavirus infection
- Parent/guardian will inform the school as soon as they receive the outcome of test results

*If a pupil appears seriously ill the school may phone paramedics and keep parents fully informed.

The pupil may return to school if everyone in the household has received negative results, the pupil has not had a fever in the last 48 hours.

If a pupil tests positive the school will be advised by the test, track, protect service regarding measures to be taken by other members of the school community who were in contact with the pupil
